

Board Minutes November 14, 2023

The Adams County Board of Supervisors met on Monday, November 14, 2023, at 9:00 AM with the following members present: Leland Shipley, Tony Hardisty, Chris Standley, Scott Akin, and Bobbi Maynes. The meeting was called to order by Chairperson Shipley. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited. Akin moved, seconded by Standley to approve the agenda as presented along with the minutes of November 6th regular meeting. All supervisors voted aye. Motion carried.

Moved by Hardisty, seconded by Maynes to approve Utility Permit #23-12 for SIRWA on Hickory Avenue in Jasper Township. All supervisors voted aye. Motion carried.

The Secondary Roads update was provided as follows: Reviewed some questions on the claims. Midwest Coating is going to share information on chip seal and base stabilization projects they do. Hungry Canyons project on Mulberry should be done this year. Offered job to an individual and should be starting December 1. Paint crew finished up. Tubes being replaced on 255th and Quartz Ave. Finished the asphalt patch work on Kale. Quincy 8 still waiting on guard rail to finish that project and get it opened back up. Working with City on drainage issues on Hull Street. Over budget on new equipment due to ordering last fiscal year and coming in this fiscal year. Will be getting reimbursed from Railroad, Purple Wave, and grants.
