

Board Minutes June 23, 2025

The Adams County Board of Supervisors met on Monday, June 23, 2025, at 9:00 AM with the following members present: Tony Hardisty, Scott Akin, Leland Shipley, Bobbi Maynes, and Chris Standley. The meeting was called to order by Chairperson Hardisty at 9:00 AM. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited. Akin moved, seconded by Shipley to approve the agenda and the minutes of the June 16th meeting. All supervisors voted aye. Motion carried.

Secondary Roads Update – Last Friday Logan and Dale attended a Hungry Canyon meeting in Crawford County and toured structures from 1990s. Dale and Nick attended a pre-construction meeting with Godbersen-Smith Construction Co. for the Colony 19 bridge replacement project that will start July 14. Sent out road closing notice. Reminder that anyone can sign up for road notifications. Working on driveways in the Lenox area. Continue to haul rock and mow shoulders. Completed first application of dust control. Donnie has been busy spraying. Ten-Point Construction bridge approaches on Union 10 was quoted for 40 feet and added 20 feet to each side. The total cost was \$97,185.94.

Department heads reports: Conservation – Had a busy weekend at the campgrounds, a lot of beach goers and boaters. Sunday was the first day at Lake View where people could pay for two weeks to reserve spots for the Fourth of July weekend. Campgrounds are essentially full for the holiday. Activities on July 5th are youth fishing contest, scavenger hunt, and fireworks. This year the Cattlemen are sponsoring a beef hunt during the three-day weekend. Hidden eggs will be redeemed for Fire and Salt certificates. The Cattlemen will also be grilling after the youth fishing contest. We are currently demoing a six-series Kubota tractor and will also be looking at a five-series. This Saturday is a cast iron bread cooking class. The Triathlon will be on August 23. We have received all hail damage payments from ICAP, and all damaged roofs have been replaced.
