The Adams County Board of Supervisors met on Monday, August 18, 2025, at 9:00 AM with the following members present: Tony Hardisty, Scott Akin, Leland Shipley, and Bobbi Maynes. Chris Standley was absent. The meeting was called to order by Chairperson Hardisty at 9:00 AM. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited. Akin moved, seconded by Maynes to approve the agenda and the minutes of the August 11th meeting. All supervisors voted aye. Motion carried.

Secondary Roads Update – Installed four driveways. Hauled dirt for Hungry Canyon project. Installed east pier on Colony 19. Had inspections for hoist and fire extinguishers.
