

## Board Minutes June 9, 2026

The Adams County Board of Supervisors met on Tuesday, June 9, 2026, at 9:00 AM with the following members present: Chris Standley, Tony Hardisty, Bobbi Maynes, and Leland Shipley. Scott Akin was absent. The meeting was called to order by Chairperson Standley at 9:00 AM. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited. Hardisty moved, seconded by Maynes to approve the agenda and the minutes of the June 1<sup>st</sup> meeting. All supervisors voted aye. Motion carried. Public comments were received.

Secondary Roads Update – Due to rainfall water overtopped several roads and three bridges. A culvert on Redwood Avenue is in poor condition and will have a temporary fix. There were pavement blowouts on Quince Avenue and H34. Will be hauling rock to the DOT project on Quarry Road. Submitted FY26 Competitive Highway Bridge Program. Grant 7 and 8 concept statement is complete, and we are seeking a consultant to help complete our "Determination of Effect for Threatened and Endangered Species," or Form 760005. We have received check plans for Union 17 and anticipated letting date is July 7. Purple Wave will take pictures of auction items.

Shipley moved, seconded by Maynes to approve purchasing a M5050 Vermeer mower with shoe kit from Fox Welding in the amount of \$14,310. All supervisors voted aye. Motion carried.

Hardisty moved, seconded by Maynes to approve Resolution 2026-26 Transferring from Rural Basic to Secondary Roads fund in the amount of \$712,274.83. Ayes: Maynes, Shipley, Hardisty, Akin, Standley. Nays: none. Motion carried. The original resolution is on file in the Auditor's office.

Maynes moved, seconded by Shipley to approve the renewal of ICAP insurance. All supervisors voted aye. Motion carried.

The June 2, 2026, Primary Election was canvassed as follows: No obvious clerical errors were identified during the canvass and there were no provisional ballots. A total of 519 votes were cast in Adams County at the Primary Election on June 2, 2026. Candidates nominated by the Republican Party were: County Supervisor 1 – Bobbi J. Maynes, County Supervisor 3 – Scott Akin, County Supervisor 4 – Leland Shipley, County Treasurer – Holly Schafer, County Recorder – Jamie Stargell, County Attorney – Andrew J. Knuth, and County Auditor TFV — Betsy Stormer. There were no candidates nominated by the Democratic Party for County Supervisor 1, County Supervisor 3, County Supervisor 4, County Treasurer, County Recorder, County Attorney, and County Auditor TFV. Shipley moved, seconded by Hardisty to accept the results of the canvass. All supervisors voted aye. Motion carried.

Department heads reports: IT – There has been a bill introduced in the Senate to fund MS-ISAC which provides useful cybersecurity. This would eliminate the need for us to pay to be a member. The White House stated CISA will provide services to state and local government entities. Presented Project 99 information from ITAG Conference which shows that Adams County ranks 5<sup>th</sup> in the state for key Internet & email security.
